Workplace Accident and Injury Policy	Policy Number: PA-403

**Purpose:** As part of Pinnguaq's duty to provide a safe work environment and to prevent potential hazards, accidents and injuries that occur in the workplace must be reported by employees.

**Policy Statement:** Workplace accidents and injuries must be reported to the joint health and safety committee, and documented to prevent future occurrences and protect the health and safety of employees.

## 1. Definitions:

a. Workplace Injury (non-critical): If a worker needs medical attention or is unable to do their work due to an accident, explosion, fire, or incidence of workplace violence.

## 2. Procedure:

- a. If a worker needs medical attention or is unable to do their work due to an accident, explosion, fire, or incidence of workplace violence, you must file an Incident Report Form and submit it to the joint health and safety committee or the health and safety representative.
- b. The notification must be submitted in writing within four days of the incident.
- c. The Joint Health and Safety Committee must notify the Ministry of Labour in situations of Death or Critical Injury in writing within 48 hours of the incident.
- d. Joint health and safety committee will meet within seven days, to discuss the incident, conduct appropriate follow up, and to determine future measures of prevention of similar incidents.
